MAIN CASE

2. According to the progress report No.125 submitted by the Members of the Judicial Water & Environment Commission, action in respect of installation of water treatment plants in Sunder Industrial Estate is being carried out and different industries mentioned in the report have sought further time for completion which has been granted under the circumstances. Further in respect of car wash recycling system installed at the service stations, it has been reported that there are discrepancies in the report filed by the S.P Dolphin Force which does not reconcile with the challans issued by WASA. It is reiterated that strict action shall be taken by the officers of WASA against service stations which are not complying with the directions of this Court. Report also refers to the finalization of recharge well design to be installed across major parks in Punjab. It has also been informed by the Members that ablution water tank which was constructed at Data Darbar is non-functional. PHA shall file a report as to why the tank is not being utilized as it has been constructed specifically for the purpose of accumulation of water so that PHA Lorries can be filled and different parks across Lahore could be watered



accordingly. It is directed that Director General, PHA shall ensure that not only water tank is filled but also designated Lorries should be tasked with filling the water from the tank for the purpose mentioned above. The report also makes a reference to the letter dated 16.03.2022 written by the Government of Punjab HUD & PHE Department whereby directions have been issued regarding water conservation to all PHA's across Punjab. The guidelines for water conservations have also been attached with the letter. It is directed that these guidelines will be followed in letter and spirit by PHA to whom letter is addressed.

3. The MCL has filed the report regarding pushcarts. It is commendable that considerable progress has been made in this regard and MCL is making good progress on designated sites for these pushcarts as well as grant of license.
