Report No.59 has been filed by Syed Hammad Abid, CTO, Lahore in which various measures have been highlighted which have been put in place by the traffic police of Lahore generally and specifically in respect of the holding of the cricket event PSL-5. It has been apprised that due to district security programme which has been devised by the city administration, the roads leading to the venue have to be closed at certain time which causes traffic congestion. However, the traffic police has put in its best efforts within its available resources to ensure that the flow of traffic does not get hampered on account of blockade of different roads. During the initial period of the event the Main Boulevard Gulberg was open for routine traffic. However, at

a later time owing to the number of threat alerts received by government agencies, the security plan was reviewed and this led to the closure of the Main Boulevard Gulberg at certain points. Reference was also made to the meeting held with the Chief Operating Officer of PCB. This report is placed on record and shall be considered on the next date of hearing.

2. D.G Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) also appeared and undertook that none of the officers associated with the works being conducted by the Water & Climate Commission shall be transferred.
