Report has been filed by the Judicial Water & Environmental Commission according to which proceedings are continuing in respect of installation of waste water treatment plants by the sugar industries across Punjab. A number of sugar mills have submitted their EIA along with design of the treatment plants and rest of the mills have been given time till 17.03.2021 as a final opportunity. Also it has been informed that 84.17%

of the brick kilns in Punjab as on 10.03.2021 have converted to zigzag technology. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also given a list of the experts who may be associated with the Water and Environmental Commission for formulation of short term policy for taking steps in respect of environmental pollution of Lahore. These shall be considered on the next date of hearing.

2. On 25.02.2021 an order was passed by this Court requiring the Director General, Lahore Development Authority to submit report as to whether provision has been made for 'Naya Pakistan Apartments, Lahore' project for recycling plants to be installed. Report has not been filed despite orders. One last opportunity is granted to the D.G, LDA to do so. In the meantime, it is directed that till the next date of hearing and until filing of the report by the D.G, LDA, no construction shall commence on the 'Naya Pakistan Apartments, Lahore' project being undertaken by Lahore Development Authority and until approval is granted to design the project so as to include recycling plants for water treatment. It has also been informed that the Ministry of Climate Change is in the process of introducing the efficient green building structure and for the purpose

green building Code was being formulated to promote the concept of green building constructions activities. Learned Addl.A.G shall seek instructions from the Secretary, Ministry of Climate Change, Government of Pakistan with regard to the progress on the enactment of the Code and a report shall be placed before the next date of hearing.
