The Secretary Agriculture has appeared and filed a report regarding initiatives taken with regard to stubble burning. That report is placed on the record. Learned Addl.A.G is directed to touch base with the Deputy Commissioners as well as District Police Officers of the areas of the concerned Districts and to direct them to file a report on daily basis regarding stubble burning. The District Police Officers shall pass on instructions to every Incharge of the police stations to take strict action against anyone involved in stubble burning and it is made clear that in case any incident of stubble burning is reported in the area of Incharge police station, that Incharge will be held responsible and will be held liable for contempt of the orders of this Court. These instructions shall be clearly passed on by the DPOs to the Incharge police station of their areas.

2. Learned counsel for Judicial Water & Environmental Commission has pointed out that three big projects being carried out in Lahore are in breach of the EIA which was issued to them. The Deputy Director EPA is present and may take action if the noncompliance is being made and a breach occurs on the part of the projects being undertaken by Lahore Development Authority. Report shall be filed on the next date of hearing. Adjourned to 12.11.2021.
