Main Case

The report has been filed by the Judicial Water and Environmental Commission. It refers to the Application for smart phones that has been developed by the Punjab Information Technology Board ("PITB"). By the development of Punjab Performance Management Framework where complaints can be registered by the



respect of those complaints and direct the Departments to initiate proceedings on those complaints. The Director General Public Relations Punjab is directed to advertise by all means available in the Print and the Electronics Media the fact regarding the setting up of the Application so that the general public may know about the existence of this Application and thereby create awareness regarding the issues of water conversations and environment. PHA shall hold a meeting with Director General LDA and

PHA intends to expand to other areas of Lahore. There is no doubt that action initiated by PHA is commendable and much progress has been made regarding antiencroachment drive which has been set in motion by PHA. Report has also referred to the letter written to LDA regarding horticulture plan of finance trade center Johar Town. According to learned counsel for PHA substantial amount is to be reimbursed by the LDA to PHA and lack of funds has constrained PHA in carrying out its obligations regarding horticultural plan in different areas under its jurisdiction. In this regard the Director General

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3. Report has also been filed by the Development Authority which mentioned the actions taken against various high rise buildings in respect of roof top garden or installation of solar panels. A number of properties which have complied with the direction regarding roof top gardening/solar panel has also been mentioned in the report. However learned counsel for LDA states that criminal cases are sought to be registered against owners of certain properties who had violated the sealing orders of LDA which entails criminal liability. Police has not acted on the complaint of LDA in this regard. Learned Assistant Advocate General shall convey the direction of this Court to CCPO Lahore who shall ensure that necessary follow up action is taken on the complaint filed by LDA for registration of criminal cases. The report shall be filed to this Court on the next date of hearing. It is directed that LDA shall continue to take action in this regard for compliance with the directions of this so that the matter of roof top garden/installation of solar panel is extended throughout the jurisdiction of Lahore Development Authority.
