LDA has filed its compliance report according to which action is being taken against commercial buildings regarding roof top gardening or installation of solar panels. It is directed that this action shall continue and shall be extended throughout Lahore. LDA shall also proceed against the owners of commercial buildings who are non-compliant. Further in case the needful is not done by the owners of the buildings especially banking corporations, action shall be pursued against the Chief Executive Officer or the President of the bank.

2. The Members of the Commission are directed to hold a meeting with the CEO of Central Business District which is being constructed in the center of the city of Lahore and which will have a huge impact on environmental pollution. The CEO shall present a detailed plan regarding the eco-friendliness of the entire project as also the steps being taken for making the entire project environmentally friendly. He

shall also apprise the Commission of measures in respect of water conservation and sewage.

3. The report also mentions the action taken against showrooms and the fact that the bills being sent by WASA mentions the directions issued by this Court regarding water conservation and that challan of Rs.10,000/- shall be issued to persons who are in violation of the directions issued by this Court.

4. A number of companies have given undertakings for installation of waste water treatment plants and these have also been annexed with the report. This matter shall be pursued by the Commission vigorously.

5. The report submitted by Secretary Regional Transport Authority, Lahore mentions the fact that a number of workshops have been sealed which were manufacturing Qingqi rickshaws. Some of these workshops have applied for registration in the Transport Department. The report also refers to the papers submitted by PCRWR on the subject of roof top rain water harvesting system. WWF officials have also shown interest in the project and their support for its execution. The project is proposed to be installed at Nishtar Park Sports Complex. Further report shall be filed on the next date of hearing. Finally, it is submitted by Syed Kamal Ali Haider, Advocate/ Member of the Commission that a meeting is due to be held with the School Education Department with regard to the issue of plying of buses by firstly the private schools for school children.
