2. Report has been filed by the Water Commission regarding measures which are being taken. The representative of the Environmental Protection Agency has submitted that 90% of the brick kilns have been


converted to zigzag technology. Also that an amount of rupees one billion and 68 crores has been collected by way of aquifer charges. However, it has been noted that brick kilns in the area of District Sheikhpura, Hafizabad and Gujranwala are being operated with impunity. It is directed that action shall be taken against brick kilns operating in that area. In this regard Deputy Commissioners of these districts are directed to lend support to the Environmental Protection Department in order to stop operation of these brick kilns which is being done illegally.
