Learned Addl.A.G shall seek instructions regarding closure of schools at an early date preferably from 20th of this month onwards till 1st of January, 2022 at least because of the fog which has descended not only on Lahore but entire cities of Central Punjab and coupled with smog is creating havoc not only in terms of health but also for people commuting between different cities.

2. Learned counsel for Judicial Water and Environmental Commission has filed a report which

gives forth various steps taken for the control of smog. Also focal person of CTO Lahore is present and admits that 250 cemented barriers have been handed over which have been placed at different places in Lahore.

3. Learned counsel for LDA states that Bedian Chowk and Bhatta Chowk are places of enormous congestion and come within the jurisdiction of Secretary, C&W. Learned Addl.A.G shall seek instructions in this regard and the Secretary C&W shall appoint an officer to coordinate with the Chief Engineer, TEPA to facilitate remodeling of entire area.

4. Learned Addl.A.G has also informed that brick kilns on whom penalties and fines are being imposed are not deposited by them. In case deposit is not made within one week of the imposition of the fine, the brick kilns which are noncompliant shall be sealed forthwith.
