of the Commission contacted the Deputy Commissioner and a letter was written to which a reply was forwarded on 09.02.2022. Further, report has been submitted on 14.02.2022 in which apart from unconditional apology, Deputy Commissioner Rahimyar Khan has undertaken that the orders of the Court shall be complied with and also that the fine of Rs.50,000/- at least as directed by this Court shall be imposed and no fine lesser to this amount shall be imposed. Further that wide publicity shall be made regarding the fact of stubble burning being an act subject to penalty and this has already been done according to the Members of the Commission. Also, according to the learned Members of the Commission, letters have been written to all the Deputy Commissioners of the Districts and reports have been sought with regard to stubble burning and the steps taken for controlling the act on the part of the farmers.

3. It has been informed that ablution water tank at BZU Shrine, Multan has been completed and is functional now. Also it is informed that PC1 has been prepared for some other shrines for construction of ablution tanks but the financial year is at end and a revision in the next budget will be required to be made. It is directed that the Finance Department shall place for

revision of these projects in the next budgetary allocation.

- 4. It has been informed that the Registrar Cooperative Societies is not cooperating with the orders passed by this Court. Learned A.A.G shall touch base with the Registrar and inform him regarding the pendency of this petition as also that he is obliged to cooperate and extend all assistance to the Members of the Judicial Commission.
- 5. Learned counsel for the LDA as also newly appointed Chief Engineer, TEPA is present and submits that a report regarding issues as directed by this Court *inter alia* rooftop gardening etc will be discussed in the forthcoming meeting on Monday and the report shall be submitted on the next date of hearing. In compliance of the directions of this Court, report has been submitted by the Commissioner, Lahore, regarding Bedian road underpass according to which a letter has been written to C&W Department for including this project in the next financial year.
