Report has been filed by Members of the Judicial Water and Environmental Commission which refers to the proceedings conducted against 16 industrial units situated in Sundar Industrial Estate to whom notices have been issued for installation of treatment plants.

Proceedings are at different stages and may be continued by the Members of the Commission.

- Report also refers to the matter relating to 2. environmental pollution undertaken by Departments including LDA, MCL and PHA. Directions have been issued by the Members of the Commission which are in compliance of the orders of this Court. PHA has been directed to get it actively involved in the ante-encroachment operation and to reclaim greenbelts and green areas. Ms. Hina Hafeezullah Ishaq Advocate, one of the Members argued that concrete structure has been built on the greenbelts which are impediments in the free flow of natural recharge of ground water which is the primary purpose of greenbelts and green areas. It is directed that PHA shall undertake operation to the removal of such obstacles and concrete structure which has been unnecessarily constructed so as to enable recharge of ground water.
- 3. Further in the report it has been submitted that the meeting has been conducted with the Commissioner Lahore who is directed to initiate process for permanent place to be earmarked for pushcarts so that they may not be spread out all around Lahore which is a major cause of traffic congestion. Learned Members of the Commission shall touch base with the Commissioner
