Main Case

2. Two further reports have been placed on record on behalf of the Commission. The first report highlights the benefit which have been accrued on account of the tangible steps taken by the Commission. Learned A.A.G shall place this report in the next meeting to be held by the Chief Secretary on the issue. The second report highlights the

substantial steps taken by the Commission regarding the sealing of the factories which are injecting sewage/ waste water into the groundwater and the progress made on the installation of the treatment plants. This report too shows substantial progress to have been made by the Commission. In this regard, it is directed that the follow up steps shall be taken by the Commission so that the factories and industrial units which have been identified to be involved in this practice are stopped from doing this and a permanent solution is found in this regard by the installation of proper treatment plants. It has also been brought to the notice of this Court that a number of car washing stations have cared to install recycling system. The Commission shall also take steps for initiating mandatory installation of the car washing re-cycling systems in all the petrol pumps in the area comprising Lahore Cantonment Board as well as DHA. The report also brings forth the fact that the Govt. of the Punjab has allocated the funds for the construction of plant water tanks at the shrine of Hazrat Data Gunj Bukhsh. The Secretary Auqaf is directed to release the funds so that the water tanks may be constructed at the earliest.

3. Learned A.A.G has placed on record the report from the SSP Secretariat Lahore which is in compliance of the direction issued by this Court
