According to the learned counsel for Water
Commission, the issue relating to purchase of lorries
depends upon execution of an MOU between PHA
and Coca-Cola Beverages Pvt. Ltd. and which is
likely to finalize today. Thereafter the Secretary
Finance shall proceed with the approval of the funds
for the purchase of lorries.

2. Learned counsel for Water Commission further
submits that the issue relating to the construction of
the water tank at Data Darbar is also being proceeded
with however the matter is being delayed on account
of being beyond the control of the contractor.
However, it is likely to be finalized in May, 2020.

3. A report has been submitted on behalf of the Secretary Education which is placed on record. PSL-5 has come to an end now and in order to make the event more efficient for the next year, notices are issued to PCB. The Chief Operating Officer, PCB shall appear on the next date of hearing.
4. Reply has been filed by the petitioner to C.M No.10 of 2020. Learned A.A.G shall also file reply to this application, in that, this is a government owned company and the plot was designated as a plot for the setting up of treatment plant for which the government has to contribute equally.
5. The compliance report regarding the disuse of polythene bags has also been placed on record by Environmental Protection Agency. According to the report, there are certain shopping centers, departmental stores, shopping malls, hotels etc. are not complying with the orders of this Court. E.P.A is directed to extend them two weeks more time so that they are compliant. Similar order is being passed in respect of other major cities in the first phase, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Sheikhupura, Rawalpindi and Multan. A time period of two weeks is granted to them to make compliance of the orders.
6. The preliminary report has been submitted by Mr. Salman Akram Raja, Advocate on behalf of some of multinational companies to whom notices

were issued with regard to plastic bottles in which water is being dispensed with and being marketed. He points out indicative collection points pursuant to the incorporation of the company under Section 42 of the Companies Act, 2017 and in which the sponsors of Memorandum of Association have been mentioned as Pepsi Co., Coca-Cola, Nestle etc. The learned counsel for the petitioner shall also submit report and place on record documents which may also bring forth the best practices being followed by those multinational companies.

7. Learned Asst. Attorney General has placed on record a report submitted by the Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division) however, the learned Asst. Attorney General shall apprise this Court of the next steps which have been taken pursuant to the report of D.G with regard to the use of Euro-4 fuels in vehicles in Pakistan.
