Report No.97 has been filed by the Water and

Environmental Commission. In that report, it has been

brought forth that a direction has been issued to the Secretary Environment, Government of Punjab for submission of smog action plan for the year 2021 as the season is around the corner. However, it is directed that the Water and Environmental Commission shall chair a meeting with the Secretary Environment and a plan regarding control of smog shall be submitted to this Court on the next date of hearing. It has also been stated in para 4 of the report that in collaboration with the WWF, Commission has designed a recharge well on experimental basis which has been installed at Punjab University Lahore. The results are still awaited and a report to this effect shall be filed on the next date of hearing. Also that Punjab Food Authority is disposing of confiscated hazardous food items in a manner which is not conducive to the environment and Punjab Food Authority has been required to submit required standards for which such hazardous food items may be disposed of so as not be a danger to the environment as well as climate and should not dispose of in waste water drains or fresh water streams.

2. Learned Deputy Attorney General shall also touch base with the Director General, PSCIR at Lahore and inquire regarding the progress in the development of

smog towers since a statement was given before this Court and a six month time was required for the development and installation of these towers. The Director General, PHA shall also be present on the next date of hearing with regard to the measures taken to control the heat wave which according to the latest data contributed to at least 7 million deaths per year throughout the world.
