The counsel for Water Commission has placed the terms of reference on record which were settled in the meeting presided by Chief Secretary and the Water Commission. At page 7 of the report, the various steps taken by the Department of Industries & Commerce, Govt. of the Punjab have been mentioned regarding control of smog. The report also contains a plan for setting up rain water harvesting system in the Punjab. Learned Addl. A.G shall seek instructions from the Secretary as to whether the funds can be allocated in the current budget for these projects. The counsel for Water Commission apprised this Court that the officers assigned to carrying out the directions of this Court and of the Water Commission are handicapped, in that, they do not have vehicles for traveling within

the areas of their assignment. The Secretary Environment is directed to provide a road worth vehicle to the officers who have been assigned the duties to carryout the orders of this Court. A report shall be filed on the next date of hearing.

2. It was next informed that a meeting regarding traffic congestion of Lahore is to take place today. The report regarding an outcome of that meeting shall also be placed on record. It was omitted in the last order that the ban on use of plastic bags has been extended in the whole of the Punjab. That order is being made today and a direction is issued to all concerned specially the Environmental Protection Department to enforce the ban at all cost. It is also ordered that the ban on the use of plastic bags shall be extended on the Motorways and for the purpose, E.P.D shall touch base with the Motorway police regarding service stations along the Motorways.
