Learned counsel for the petitioner shall provide video clips of the advertisements which have been prepared for instruction to general public regarding the urgent need for conservation of water as a resource. Learned A.A.G shall touch base with the relevant officer of PEMRA for onward necessary instructions to the electronic media for relaying those advertisements so that a message can be put across the board.

2. Report has been filed on behalf of the Environment Protection Department, Government of Punjab in which it has been informed that all the brick kilns operating in Punjab shall be closed down from 01.11.2019 to 20.12.2019 which do not operate on new technology. Depending on the situation then, a decision

shall be made regarding extension in the ban so imposed.

3. Learned counsel for Water Commission has informed that three inlet units which were charging sewer and pollutants into the canal water have been stopped and also that the petrol pumps and service stations which had not installed recycling plants have been sealed and have been required to do so within a period of 15 days. It has also been informed that Lahore Cantonment Board has started construction of ablution tanks in two of the bigger mosques in that area. It shall follow suit for the rest of the mosques. It has also been stated that the Registrar Cooperative Societies was called by the Commission and he has undertaken to inspect the large mosques in various housing societies to compel them to construct ablution tanks. Report to this effect shall also be submitted.

4. Learned counsel argues that the focal person who was attached to the Water Commission has gone on leave. The Deputy Commissioner, Lahore is directed to depute a focal person/ Assistant Commissioner who has been posted in place to assist the Water Commission in the functions being performed and to continue to perform those functions.

5. Adjourned to 31.10.2019.
