Report has been filed by the Members of the  
Commission. It has been pointed out that car washing  
generally by the residents of the District of Lahore  
continues unabated. In this regard it is directed that the  
Members of the Commission shall engage Dolphin force  
for reporting any such instances. WASA is directed to  
serve notices on all housing societies within Lahore  
District in order to inform them that henceforth fine of  
Rs.5000/- shall be imposed on persons who are found  
involved in car washing by pipes at their residences.

2. Further the report mentions the development regarding complaint system in the general public being developed by the PITB. It is also directed that PITB shall take measures for setting up of website of the Commission set up by this Court so that all information including directions issued by this Court are available on the website of the Water and Environmental Commission.

3. A number of complaints were raised against the conduct of PHA and its officers. Learned counsel for PHA present in the Court is directed to inform the Director General, PHA to appoint a focal person who shall liaison with the Members of the Commission in all matters which are required to be dealt with by PHA. Similarly LDA is also directed to appoint a focal person with whom the Members of the Commission can interact.

4. Learned D.A.G present on Court's call, shall inform the I.G Motorway regarding the duties which were previously cast upon members of the forces to inform the relevant quarters regarding stubble burning which takes place along all motorways. It has been informed that the instances regarding stubble burning are continuing without any letup. The office memo shall be issued by I.G Motorway addressed to all field officers

and a duty shall be cast upon them to inform regarding stubble burning at once along with detail of the areas in which violations takes place.

5. Report also includes a report by WWF regarding ground water resources in Lahore. The Members of the Commission shall engage with WWF so that concerted effort may be taken regarding the important issue of ground water resource and its preservation.

6. According to the learned counsel for LDA final notices have been served upon commercial buildings along with Main Boulevard of Lahore. It is directed that if non-compliance is made by these buildings, LDA shall proceed to take action regarding those buildings including sealing of these buildings until compliance is made of the orders of this Court and the Regulation of LDA in regard to rooftop gardening.
