
Report No.102 has been filed by the Judicial Water

Commission in which details have been given regarding



vehicles which is commendable and shall be continuing without any let. It has also been stated in the report that transport department has also acted on the directions of this Court and inspected 4634 vehicles, out of which 8904 were issued warning and rest of 1752 smog emitting vehicles were challaned and substantial amount of fines has also been imposed.

- 2. It has also been informed that under the directions of this Court, Chief Secretary, Punjab has convened a meeting for the purpose of stubble burning for 02.11.2021. Report shall be filed thereafter. Learned Addl.A.G has produced a report by the Agricultural Department regarding smog awareness campaign and for action taken in respect of stubble burning by the said department. This is also placed on the record.
- 3. In respect of C.M.No.32/2020 a report has been filed by the WASA which is placed on the record and a copy of which is given to the learned counsel for the applicant and shall be considered on the next date of hearing.
- 4. As directed by this Court, according to learned counsel for the LDA, garbage including machinery etc dumped on the road which was directed to be constructed adjacent to the Banking Court has been

cleared. Learned counsel for the applicant who is practicing lawyer and who appeared before the Court ever day has taken a strong exception to the statement made by the learned counsel for LDA and has produced pictures to substantiate his claim that nothing has been done regarding carpeting of the road etc. Mr. Anis Ali Hashmi, Additional Advocate General is appointed as Local Commission to inspect the said road and to file a report on the next date of hearing and thereafter this Court will act on that report for further steps. Learned Local Commission shall associate representative of LDA and WASA while carrying the inspection and the applicants may also appoint a representative to associate in the entire exercise.
