MAIN CASE

2. Learned Members of the Commission have placed
on the record report No.132. It refers to the issues which
are ongoing and are being dealt with by the Commission
at different levels. It is also informed that the Members
of the Commission are in negotiations with certain

multinational companies regarding recycling of solid waste and reuse of plastic. Further report shall be submitted on the next date of hearing.

3. | Learned counsel for PHA has submitted that there are certain unresolved issues with LDA and which have constrained PHA from taking over certain parks and green areas for development and maintenance. It is directed that a meeting shall be held between the authorized officers of both LDA and PHA to resolve the issues and a combined report shall be placed on the record on the next date of hearing on which necessary directions shall be issued. Learned counsel further requests that members of the PHA require support of police for removal of encroachments and billboards etc within PHA jurisdiction. In this regard DIG (Operations), Lahore is directed to make necessary arrangements for which PHA shall reimburse the costs to Lahore police for such support. Further learned D.A.G shall ensure that the public welfare messages are aired on different electronic channels and PEMRA should issue necessary instructions in this regard. This will give a long way in raising the awareness amongst different segments of the society. |


4. | Learned Members of the Commission have informed that the two police officers who were deputed

to escort them for their visits to different places in connection with the task assigned to them by this Court have been withdrawn for the last one month and no new officers have been assigned to take up the duty. Once again DIG (Operations) Lahore is directed to ensure that replacement of offices is provided to the Members of the Commission for their security on visits to different areas on the directions of this Court.

5. Mr. Moazzam Ali Shah, Advocate has informed that a law which was approved by the Government of Punjab relating to Spatial Planning has not been placed before the Provincial Assembly for making into law. Learned Assistant Advocate General shall seek instructions in this regard and inform this Court on the next date of hearing. It is reiterated that D.G, PHA shall place on the record the policy and planning of PHA going forward and regarding which directions may be issued by this Court. It is once again directed that a clear vision of different actions which the PHA intends to take shall be reflected in the report filed before this Court on the next date of hearing.
